- **Interpersonal Strength**
Discover how to be authentic, confident, resilient and optimistic in any situation.
- **Healthy Relationships with Yourself & Others**
Discuss how to establish appropriate personal boundaries and express them in a positive way; delve into social media topics and explore alternative social activities.
- **Explore Goal Setting for Future Aspirations**
What types of goals do you have for your life?
What is one thing you want to do in the future?

This overnight conference for girls ages 14 - 17 provides an overview of leadership with an emphasis on identity and self. Through lectures, light-hearted debates, real-life simulations and hands-on activities, attendees build an understanding of respect for self and others while building a rapport with peers. Topics will include:

- **Professional & Skill Development**
Improve your public speaking, conflict resolution, communication, problem solving, networking, self-advocacy and goal setting skills.
- **Collaboration**
Participate in team or group-based activities and relationship-building experiences within diverse groups of peers.
- **Mentorship**
Attendees will have the opportunity to both receive mentoring and to mentor other participants with trained staff and volunteer involvement and oversight.
- **Meaningful Opportunities**
Explore a cause that you find important, want to learn more about or think should be investigated further.
