## 2026 Scholarship Application Information



### Applications must be postmarked no later than March 15, 2026.

Please note that many scholarships in the **Masonic Scholarship Resource Guide** require the filing of a separate application. Read each scholarship description carefully. Contact information is included in each award description, and can be used to obtain additional application materials, where required.

- 1. You must use the official 2026 application. Applications from previous years will NOT be considered. We will penalize or disqualify late applications.
- 2. You may obtain the current application by requesting one from our office or from our website at <a href="https://www.pmyf.org">www.pmyf.org</a> by clicking the "Scholarships" button.
- We STRONGLY prefer that you type your application. Both a blank printable form and a fill-in form are available on our website. Applications and supporting materials must be submitted via mail. Online submissions will not be accepted.
- 4. The ONLINE FILL-IN APPLICATION:
  - a. You will need Adobe Acrobat Reader to open and fill-in the form. Version 5.0 or higher is recommended.
  - b. You will be able to type and print your application with the free version of Acrobat, but you will NOT be able to save your work, unless you are running the full commercial version.
- 5. Complete all information. Where needed, mark items as "Not Applicable" rather than leaving blanks. Although we welcome supplementary material in the form of attached documents, do not substitute attachments for completing sections of the application. We will not contact you for information not included in your application.
- 6. Be sure to *include all required attachments*. Use the checklist provided with the application. It is recommended to collect all necessary materials in advance. While we allow items, such as transcripts, to be mailed directly from your institution, we may not accept these items if they arrive late. *We will not consider incomplete applications*.
- 7. Check your work. Your neatness and correctness will be considered.

#### **BASIC ELIGIBILITY**

To be eligible to receive a scholarship from the Educational Endowment Fund of the PA Masonic Youth Foundation, an applicant must be a member in good standing of a Pennsylvania Masonic Lodge working under the jurisdiction of the Right Worshipful Grand Lodge of Free and Accepted Masons of Pennsylvania, his child, step-child, grandchild, great grandchild, step-grandchild, sibling or dependent (IRS definition) (or one who was in good standing at the time of his death); **OR** a present or former member in good standing of one of the Pennsylvania Masonic-related youth groups; **OR** a resident or graduate of the Pennsylvania Masonic Homes for Children. The applicant must be a High School graduate, or a High School Senior who is pursuing higher education. Applicants must have a minimum 3.0 GPA to be considered. This grant is only applicable to undergraduate tuition and fees.

#### **FINANCIAL NEED**

While we recognize that college is expensive for even the highest income families, we have based our financial need standards on the range of incomes of our applicants. If your household has a large income, relative to the number of people in it, you should not expect to receive an award. We do consider special financial circumstances if you make us aware of them.

# 2026 Scholarship Application Instructions



## Applications must be postmarked no later than March 15, 2026.

This is a highly competitive grant program and cannot be given to all that apply. Please type application or print in ink. Do not use pencil. *Incomplete applications will not be considered.* Applications *will not be considered* without each of these items:

- 1. All pages of this application, with complete information. Be sure to sign and date the application on the last page. Original transcript of your most recent completed academic year (high school or college.) Digitally authenticated transcripts, emailed directly from the issuing institution, are acceptable. If you are in your first year of college, please include a transcript of your first semester's grades in addition to that of your last completed academic year.
- 2. Copy of pages 1 and 2 of **your** most recent U. S. Individual Income Tax Return, IRS Form 1040, 1040A or 1040 EZ. Also, a copy of the same for **your parent** or guardian, if you are claimed by them as a legal dependent. If the current year return has not yet been filed, a copy of the immediately preceding year's return will be sufficient. Please do not send accompanying tax schedules. They are NOT necessary. If you are under the age of 22 and not claimed as a dependent, you must attach an explanation.
- 3. A copy of the current dues card of your Masonic relative, or, a letter of certification from the Lodge Secretary or Worshipful Master of the Lodge of your brother, father, step-father, grandfather or legal guardian; or a letter from your Masonic-related youth group leader, certifying eligibility; or documentation showing your connection to the Masonic Homes for Children of Pennsylvania. THIS IS NOT A LETTER OF REFERENCE. IT ONLY VERIFIES THAT YOU ARE ELIGIBLE UNDER THE ESTABLISHED CRITERIA. If you cannot provide this proof of eligibility, include a separate written statement explaining why you cannot do this.
- 4. Properly labeled pages containing the completion of any answers in this application, and any additional information you would like the committee to consider.
